[Curriculum and Credit Framework (CCF, 2022)] offered by Sagar
Mahavidyalaya, affiliated to the University of Calcutta, is merit based. Applicants are instructed to read carefully the guidelines provided below and the eligibility criterion before filling in the application form online.

+ Undergraduate admissions for 2023-24 will be conducted online only through the designated admission portal of Sagar Mahavidyalaya www.sagarmv.ac.in
+ Applicants must register through the above portal before online application. The entire procedures of application and admission are online. There is no provision for offline application for admission.
+ Online Application for admission to Four-year B.A. (Honours with or without Research) and Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. (Multidisciplinary) courses for the academic year 2023-24 will open on and from 01.07.2023, Saturday to $\mathbf{1 5 . 0 7 . 2 0 2 3}$, Saturday. Applicants will apply online only through the admission portal of the college: www.admissionsagarcollege.com
+ Subject-wise Merit Lists (provisional) will be published on 16.07.2023, Sunday by 2p.m.
+ Reporting of discrepancies by valid candidates should be mailed by 2 P.M. of 17.07.2023, Monday positively at sagarmvadmission@gmail.com
+ Applicants are required to apply online within the stipulated time period mentioned above and follow the Admission Schedules and other notifications published on the portal regularly.
+ Classes for $1^{\text {st }}$ Semester (2023-24 session) of all Four-Year B.A. (Honours with or without Research) and Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. (Multidisciplinary) Courses will commence from 01.08.2023 (Tuesday).
+ Students who have passed the 10+2 level examination in 2023 and previous years from any recognized board in India (e.g. ISC, CBSE, West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education, other boards of West Bengal and other states) are eligible to seek admission to the 1st year for Four-Year B.A. (Honours with or without Research) and Three-Year B.A./B.Sc.
(Multidisciplinary) Courses of Studies provided the candidate has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100. However no students shall be
allowed to take admission after a lapse of more than three years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination (Explanation:- The year of admission shall not be taken into
+ Candidates who have completed vocational courses are only eligible to admit in the Three-Year B.A. (Multidisciplinary) Courses.


## Procedure of Online Application:

+ Eligible candidates must register themselves on the college admission portal www.sagarmv.ac.in and then proceed to online application.
+ During the application, all fields mentioned on the application form should be correctly entered after careful consideration. Candidates should revise and preview their application forms before final submission. However, students can change/edit their data/information themselves through the admission portal during the application period (till $15.07 .2023,11.59 \mathrm{PM}$ ). No change/editing is possible once the Merit List (Provisional) is published.
+ Candidates who fail to upload the required documents along with requisite payment during online application will not be considered in the Merit List (provisional).
+ The college is not liable for any erroneous information provided by the candidates. Admission is liable to be cancelled if a candidate is found guilty of suppression or of misrepresentation of materials/facts at any stage.
+ Candidates can apply $24 \times 7$ during the above-mentioned period. After online submission of application and uploading of documents, applicants are required to download submitted form generated and save the same for future reference.
+ Candidates should be cautious of information that might be available from other sources and beware of fraudulent activities. The college will not be responsible if the applicants fail to follow the communications made through the designated admission portal.
+ Candidates must take a print-out of the application form generated after successful online submission and produce the same only at the time of verification or whenever required
+ Applicants are not required to physically report to the college campus/ office for submission of documents or for any other reason during the admission process. Candidates will have physically report to the college only after admission for verification of documents as and when notified by the college.
+ Candidates will be informed through e-mail and SMS after successful online submission of application. In case of DND settings in applicant's contact number she may not receive any SMS. The college will not remain responsible in such cases.
+ Successful submission of application does not ensure admission of a candidate. Applicants will be called for admission only on the basis of the Merit List (provisional) published on the portal.

Admission to semester wise Four-Year B.A. (Honours with or without
Research) and Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. (Multidisciplinary) Courses under CCF will be guided by the Admission Regulations (Calcutta University Notification No. CSR/05/2023, Notification No. CSR/04/2023 dated 23.06.2023).

## Duration of the Courses:

Four-Year B.A. (Honours with or without Research):- The B.A. Programme shall be for a minimum duration of Eight (08) (with an exit option after completion of 2 nd/4th/6 th Semesters) consecutive semesters of Six months each, i.e. The odd semester will start ordinarily in the month of July and the even semester in the month of January of every year. A student prosecuting a regular course of study for semester wise degree course shall have to clear all semesters in all respect within a span of seven years from the year of admission to the particular course and combination, failing which enrolment of the student shall stand cancelled.

Three-Year B.A./B.Sc. (Multidisciplinary) Courses : - The B.A./ B.Sc. Programme shall be for a minimum duration of six (06) consecutive semesters (with an exit option after 2 nd and 4th) of six months each, i.e. The odd semester will start ordinarily in the month of July and the even semester in the month of January of every year. A student prosecuting a regular course of study for semester wise degree course shall have to clear all semesters in all respect within a span of seven years from the year of admission to the particular course and combination, failing which enrolment of the student shall stand cancelled.
